What is the Westcreek Greenway? A wooded, undeveloped area of land extending north from Brush Country Road to Monterey Oaks Boulevard in southwest Austin. This is a "right-of-way" area that was once slated for extension from Brush Country to Monterey Oaks. Instead, it is now Westcreek's very own greenspace. This is adjacent to [Westcreek's pocket park](#).

Westcreek Greenway Improvements include:

1. Trail head and trail improvements
2. Signage (encourage appropriate use & discourage motorized vehicles, smoking, camping, dumping, etc.)
3. Drainage improvements and erosion control
4. Safety improvements
5. A potential low-profile bridge structure over the ditch north of the Brush Country Trail Head for easier passage during wet/muddy conditions
