## Nextdoor is the private social network for your neighborhood

Nextdoor makes it easy to communicate with your neighbors about the issues that matter most in your community. Neighbors across the country are using Nextdoor to:

- Organize neighborhood events (e.g. National Night Out, HOA meetings)
- Report suspicious activities and help prevent crime

## Neighbors only

Each Nextdoor website is password protected and private to you and your neighbors. Members must verify that they live in the neighborhood before they can join a Nextdoor website. Feel confident knowing that you are talking with people who actually live in your neighborhood.

## All your information is private

Nextdoor takes privacy very seriously. All members must verify their addresses before accessing their password protected, encrypted websites. None of the information you share on Nextdoor is available on search engines. And your personal information is not shared with advertisers or third parties.

## Make your neighborhood safer

Research has shown that one of the best ways to prevent crime is to get to know your neighbors. When neighbors know each other, they look out for one another. Nextdoor makes it easy to meet your neighbors, create watch groups, report suspicious activity and prevent crime before it happens.
